Auctions	I am Sold	We do not receive a referral fee, but may enter a split commission arrangement.
Mortgages	Various approved suppliers	Fees of 10-15% of any agreed mortgage commissions earned by the supplier.
Utility Switching	Goodlord	We earn a fee of £15-£20 per property if switched
